## Subchapter LL. Commissioner's Rules Concerning Innovative Instrutional Programs

§102.1501 Blended Learning Grant Program.

- (a) General provisions
  - (1) The Texas Education Agency (TEA) will announce and execute an open application for blended learning grants pursuant to Texas Education Code (1929)924, to assist school districts and open-enrollment charter schools in implementing effective blenderdilega models.
  - (2) "Blended learning means an instructional delivery ethod that combines classroamed online instructionandis facilitated
    - (1) TEA will make publicly available the learning grampplication, eligibility criteria, and scoring rubric. Priority will be given to school districts and oper nollment charter schools with the highest numbers of educationally disadvantaged students
    - (2) Submitted applications will be scored according to the published scoring rubrid grants will be awarded by TEA to the school is stricts and operenrollment charter schools whose applications are scored higher the rubric
    - (3) All grantees must complete the requirements optogram described in TE(\$29.924(d).
  - (c) Trainingprograms.TEA will publish a list of approved training programs pursuaritec, §29.924.TEA will approve training programs based on a scoring rubric that will be made publicly available. The list of currently approved raining programs is available on the TEMPebsite, and TEA will update the list at its discretion.

- (D) satisfactory completion or frofessional deelopment opportunities for participating teachers that is aligned to the chosen TEApproved online curriculum programend high quality instructional materials and
- (E) the administration and analysis of an approvex as Essential Knowledge and Skills aligned interim assessment that measures student growth and estimate to students
