- (b) The certificates specified in subsection (a) of this section are appropriate for a special education assignment in PrekindergarterGrade 12 except where otherwise noted.
- (c) The employing school district should make every effort to secure educators trained in the specialized skills and knowledge needed to serve the special needs of the children. If a staff member does not have the skills

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and knowledge needed for the assignment, the school district is responsible for making provisions for the person to acquire the necessary skills and knowledge.

§231.703Teacher of Adaptive Physical Education

- (a) An assignment for Teacher of Adaptive Physical Education is allowed with one of the following certificates.
 - (1) All-Level Health and Physical Education.
 - (2) All-Level Physical Education.
 - (3) Elementary Physical Education (Grades) 1(Grades -18 only).
 - (4) Grades &--Physical Education (Grades & Only).
 - (5) Physical Education: Early Childhoddrade 12.
 - (6) Secondary Physical Education (Gradet26) (Grades 612 only).
 - (7) Special education certificate as specified in §231.701 of this title (relating to Special Education Teacher). This assignment requires necessary skills and knowledge in adaptive physical education.

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(b) A teacher in an assignment for Teacher of Students with Visual Impairments must be available to students with visual impairments.
