votes than any other candidate, whether or not that number constitutes a majority of all votes cast). If the vote results in a tie for the most votes between two or more candidates, the chairperson reopens the floor for additional nominations, if any, and a second vote is taken. If there is still a tie for a plurality of the votes, the election is then postponed to the next SBEC meeting.

ASSOCIATE COMMISSIONER'S RECOMMENDATION:

Elect a Vice-Chairperson to serve a term to run through the last regularly scheduled Board meeting of 2023, or until a successor is elected.
