Proposed Review of 19 TAC Chapter 231, <u>Requirements for</u> <u>Public School Personnel Assignments</u>

DISCUSSION AND ACTION

SUMMARY: Texas Government Code (TGC), §2001.039, establishes a four-year rule review cycle for all state agency rules, including State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) rules. This item presents for SBEC approval for the proposed review of 19 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Chapter 231, <u>Requirements for Public School Personnel Assignments</u>. The rules being reviewed provide requirements relating to the criteria for school districts to make personnel assignments based on the correlating certification requirements.

STATUTORY AUTHORITY: Statutory authority for the rule review is TGC, §2001.039. The statutory authority for 19 TAC Chapter 231 is the Texas Education Code (TEC), §§21.003(a), 21.031(a), 21.041(b)(1) and (2), and 21.0486.

FUTURE ACTION EXPECTED: The review of 19 TAC Chapter 231, <u>Requirements for Public</u> <u>School Personnel Assignments</u>, is scheduled to be presented to the SBEC for adoption at the July 2024 meeting.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION AND JUSTIFICATION: The SBEC rules in 19 TAC Chapter 231, <u>Requirements for Public School Personnel Assignments</u>, establish requirements for school districts to make personnel assignments based on the correlating certification requirements.
