Texas students are required to pass five STAAR of modure exams Algebra I, English I, English II, Biology, and U.S. History to receive a high school diplomate over, a student who failed an end-of-course assessment for no more than two courses also are ceive a Texas high school diploma if the student has qualified to graduate by means of an Individual Graduation Committee determination.
