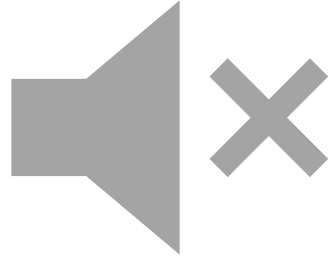

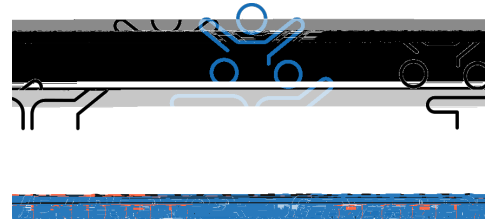

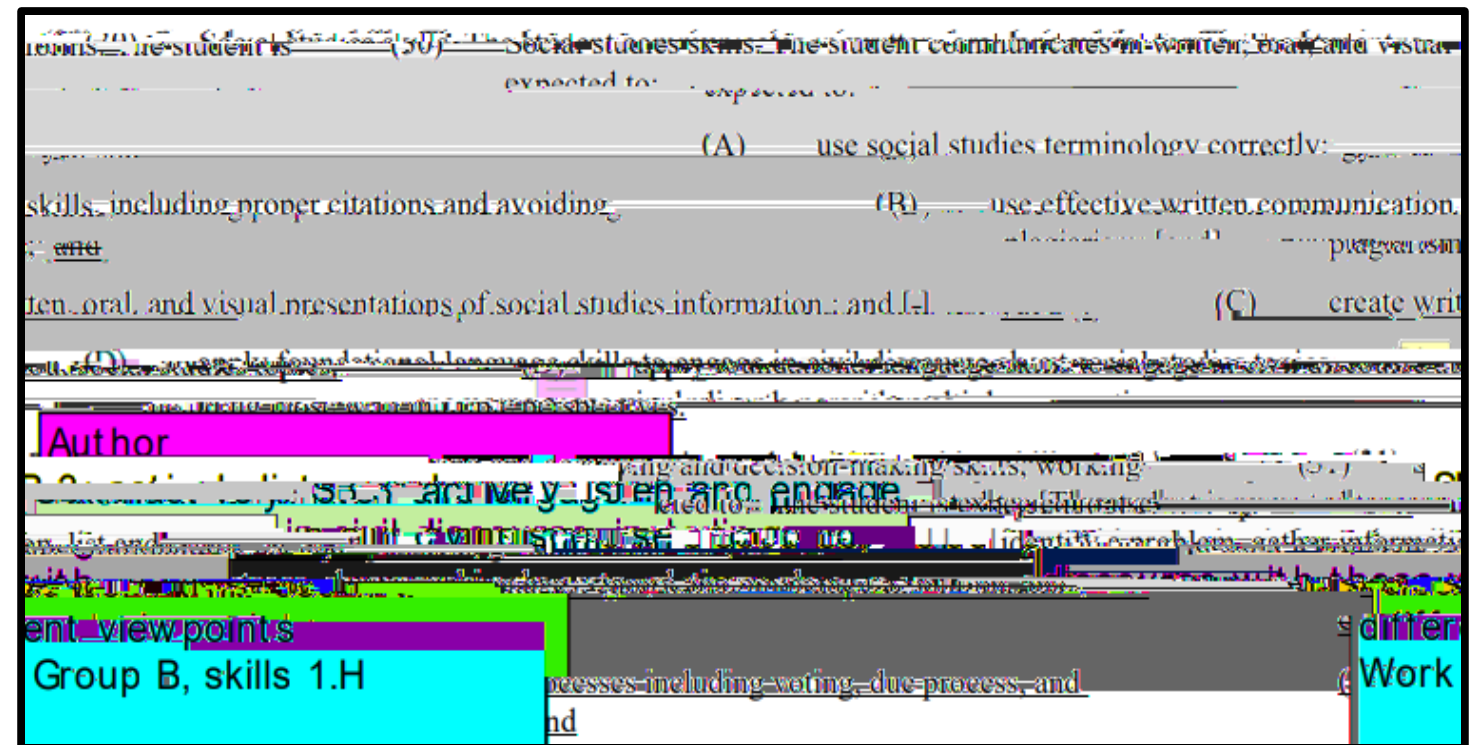
The SB 3 side-by-

Additionally, these documents include comments (noted in yellow) that show the alignment of the current student expectations to the requirements of Senate Bill 3.

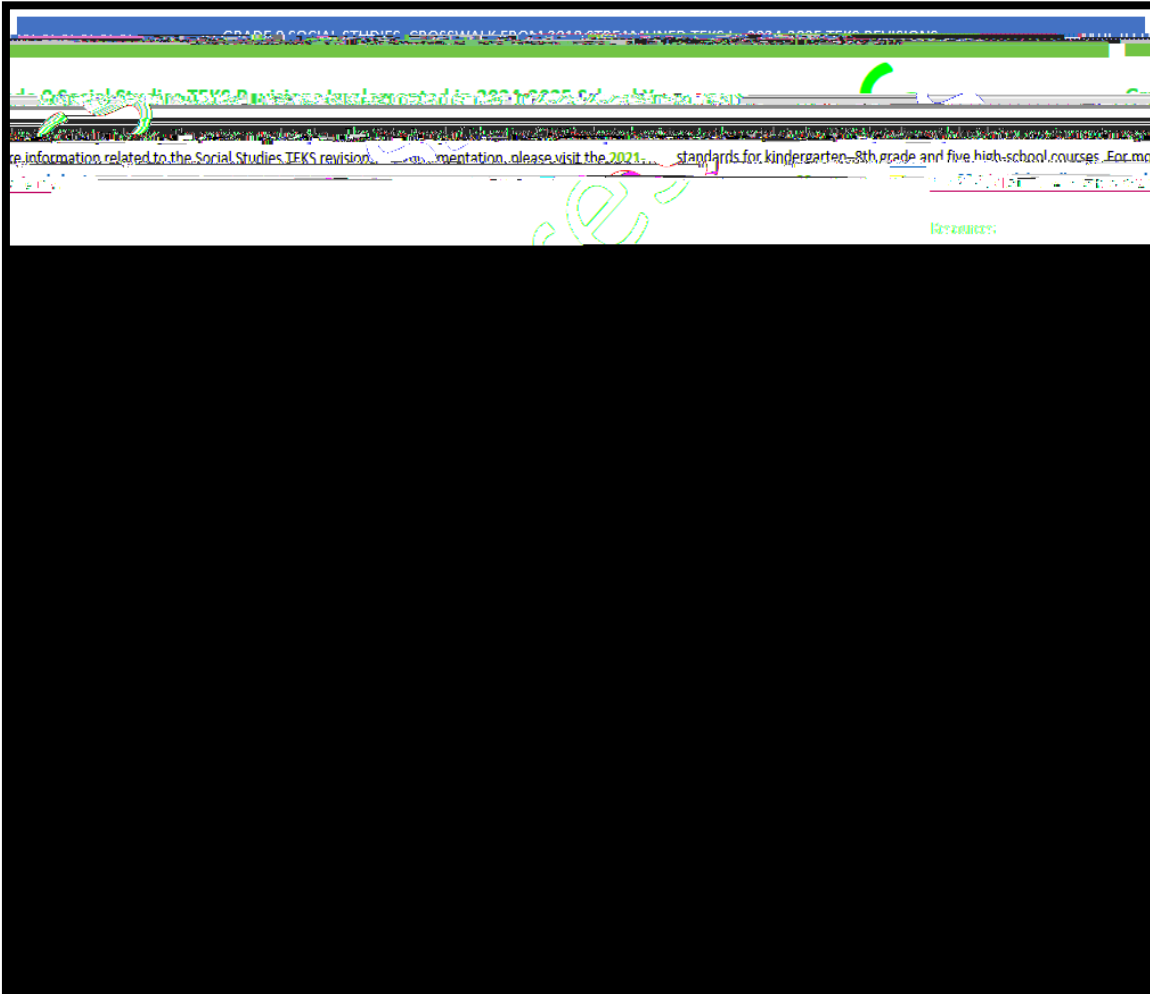

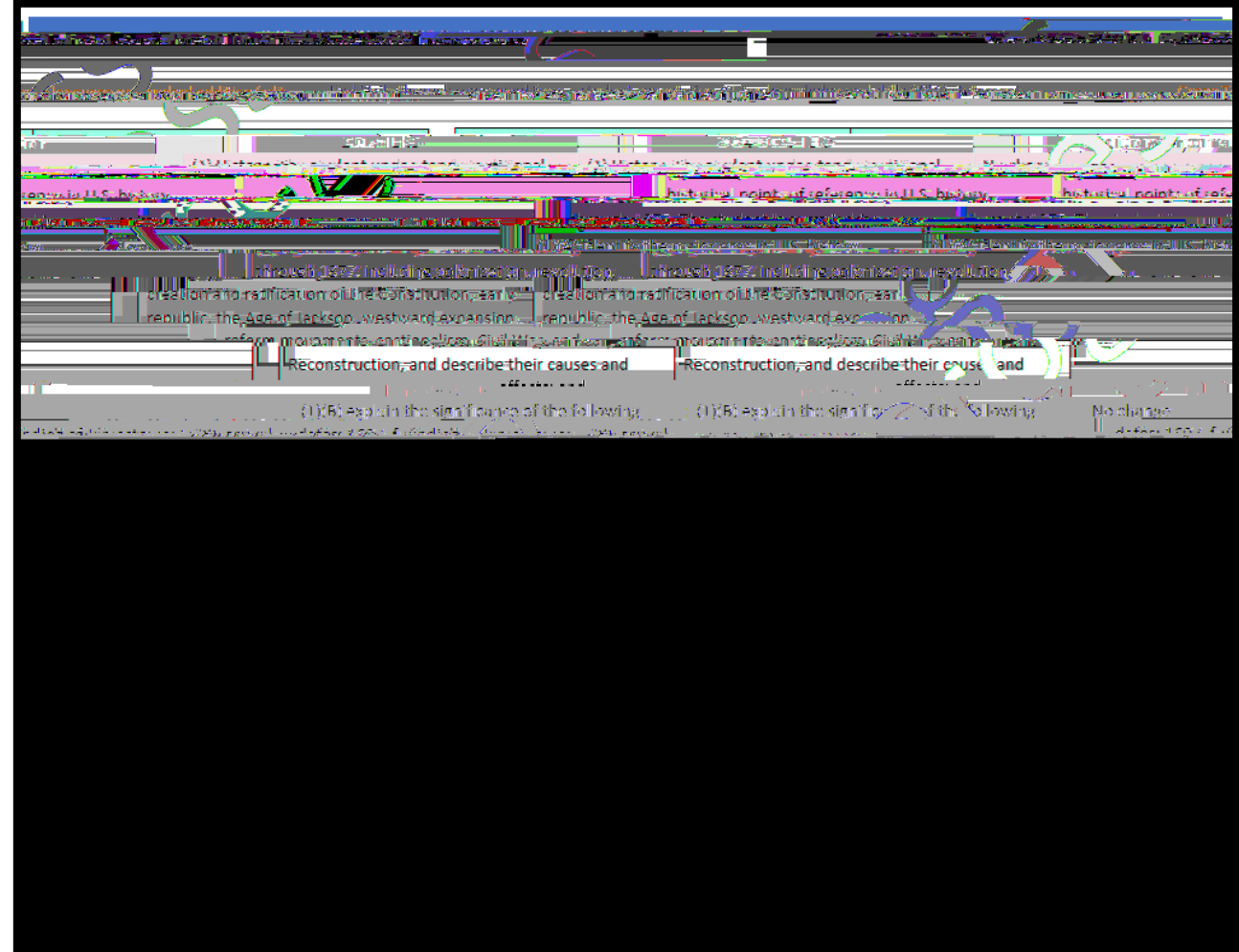

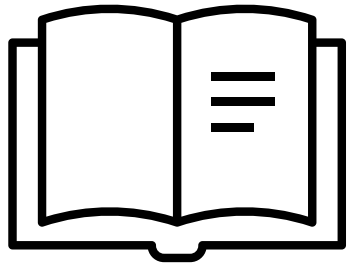
## Summary of TEKS Revisions



## Crosswalk from 2018 Streamlined TEKS to 2024-2025 TEKS Revisions



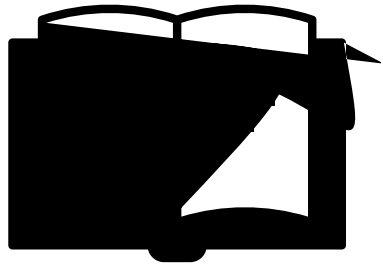




## Instructional Materials

- The State Board of Education (SBOE) voted on November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022, to amend their [instructional materials adoption cycle](#) to remove Proclamation 2025, which would have included a call for new social studies materials.
- To address the revisions to the social studies TEKS that were adopted in November 2022, the SBOE advised TEA staff to offer publishers of SBOE-adopted social studies materials the opportunity to update their materials.





## Instructional Materials

- TEA is working with publishers who wish to update their SBOE-adopted materials, and TEA plans to present those updates to the SBOE in spring 2024.
- TEA will post any update requests received from publishers to the TEA web page [Substitutions and Content Updates](#) for public review and comment prior to taking the request to the SBOE for approval.

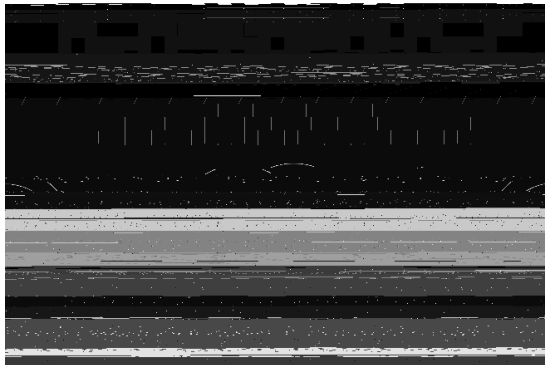

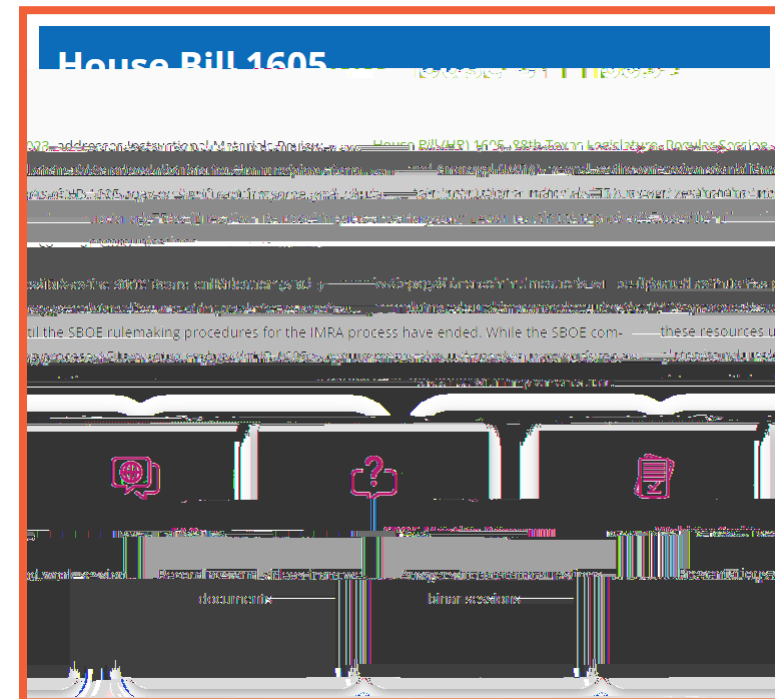

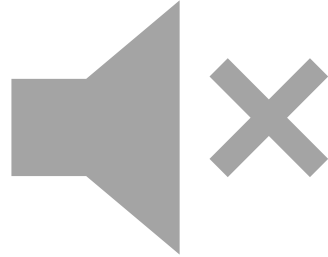
