Alvarado ISD (AISD) struggles to recruit high-quality educators due to larger surrounding school districts that provide a larger base pay. AISD offers a small-town culture, smaller teacher-to-student ratio classrooms, and administrative supports to assist with planning instruction and student behaviors. AISD promotes job opportunities on the AISD Website, at ESC11, Indeed and/or another social media platforms. AISD has been able to recruit our own high school graduates for various positions or after they have received their certification. It is a strong desire of AISD to grown their own educators, promoting the program at the Junior High and High School levels. The GYO grant would assist with stipends, curriculum, and supplies over-and-beyond what the district's budget can currently do to promote and recruit. At this time of financial concerns within the district, the stipend would assist with compensating our salary base pay to recruit a high-quality CTE educator, with a master's degree, to successful grow the E&T pathway.

2. Alvarado ISD (AISD) would ensure that the E&T educator receives the GYO grant stipend, receives support and coverage to attend all state required E&T curriculum training, and is provided with a conference period long enough to plan, collaborate with other educators and recruit addition scholars for continued growth of the program. Administrators at the high school will monitor and coach the E&T educator, as needed, for successful implementation of all indicators within the program to ensure compliance.
