The goal of the GISD Education and Training program is to prepare students for post-secondary education in the field of education and to expose students to the field so they are prepared and knowledgeable of good teaching practices. Granbury ISD is partnering with Tarleton State University to bring in dual credit courses and expand our curriculum in order to make the transition from high school to the university much easier for students. Tarleton currently uses a residency program in lieu of traditional student teaching, and the plan is to have our GISD students return to Granbury in order to do so.

We are currently hiring for the other E&T position that will teach Child Development. The principal and guidance counselors will support the CTE Director in promotion of the program and proper placement of students.

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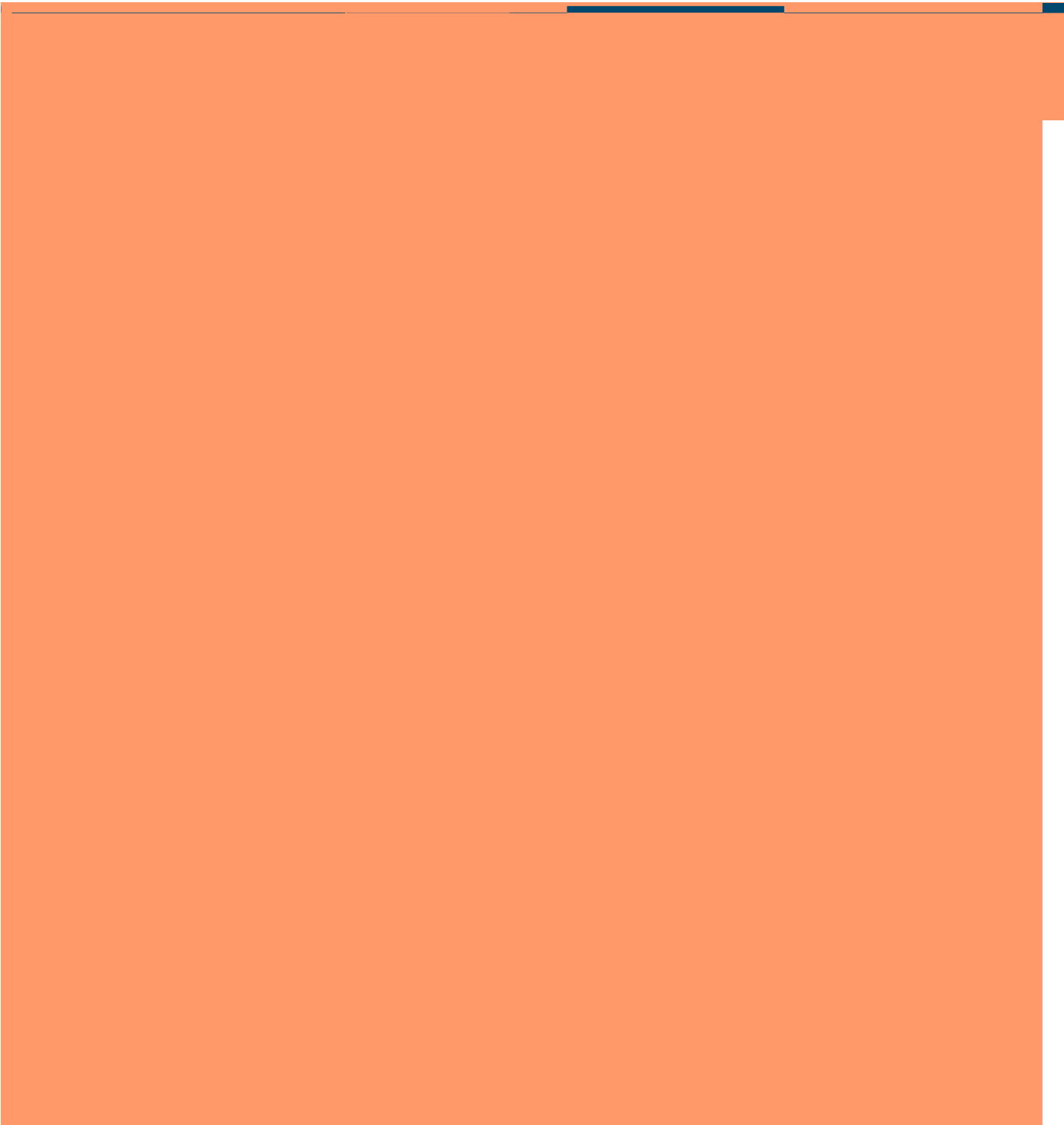
