Advanced Placement Results for Texas and the United States

In the 202223 school year, a total @51,195 students in all grades in Texas public and nonpublic schools tool634,995 Advanced Placement (AP) examinations (Table 1). Texas ranked second in the nation in both number of AP examinees and number of AP examinations taken2(**Table ges**).

Between2021-22 and 2022-23, the number of AP examinations takenreasedby 10.0percent in Texas, compared **1** percent in the United States as a whole (Table 1). The percentage of examinations with scores in the **3** range increased by 0.8 percentage points in Texas and by percentage points in the United States.
