Highlights

- In the fall of 2001, the Texas Education Agency (TEA) submitted Texas public school 1999-00 dropout data to the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES). The data complied with the NCES dropout definition. In August 2002, NCES (2002c) released the data submitted by 37 states, including the District of Columbia.
- Out of the 37 states in compliance, dropout rates ranged from 2.5 to 9.2 percent. The Texas rate of 5.0 percent ranked 24th.
- The 1999-00 annual dropout rate for Grades 9-12 based on the NCES definition was 5.0 percent, 2.8 times the 1.8 percent rate based on the TEA definition.
- For Grades 9-12, there were 54,390 dropouts under the NCES definition, compared to 21,439 dropouts under the TEA accountability definition – a difference of 32,951 students. The ratio of NCES dropouts to TEA dropouts for Grades 9-12 is 2.5 to 1.
- Under the state definition, the 1999-00 Grade 9-12 annual rate for African American, Hispanic, and White students was 2.6 percent, 2.7 percent, and 1.0 percent, respectively. Under the federal definition, the annual rate for African American, Hispanic, and White students was 6.8 percent, 7.3 percent, and 2.9 percent, respectively.
- The Grade 7-12 rate was 3.5 percent under the NCES dropout definition, compared to 1.3 percent under the TEA definition.
- Under both the TEA and NCES definitions, Grade 9 had the largest number of dropouts, followed by Grade 12.
- The difference between the TEA and NCES dropout counts was greatest for Grade 12.

Introduction

The data tables and listings in this report provide secondary school dropout data at the state and district levels as a supplement to *Secondary School Completion and Dropouts in Texas Public Schools, 1999-00* (Texas Education Agency [TEA], 2001a). This supplement includes annual dropout rates calculated under the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) definition and rates calculated using the Texas accountability definition. A description of the NCES dropout definition and an explanation of the main differences between the NCES and Texas definitions are included. NCES rates for Texas and other states are provided. A district-by-district listing of 1999-00 annual dropout counts and rates for Grades 9-12 is presented (see Table 6, page 19). Listings of other completion and dropout rates based on the Texas definition at the county, district, and campus levels are available in *Secondary School Completion and Dropouts in Texas Public Schools, 1999-00: County Listings*

A study conducted for the 76th Texas Legislature by the Legislative Budget Board (LBB), State Auditor's Office, and TEA recommended that TEA prepare and submit data to NCES in compliance with the national dropout definition (LBB, 2000). The report noted that the NCES rate would not only be comparable to other state dropout rates; it would also be an independent assessment of Texas progress on dropouts. TEA has prepared and published an increasing number and variety of dropout measures over the years; preparing and submitting data to NCES is the most recent example of this.

To comply with the recommendation and avoid additional reporting requirements for the districts, the agency developed a method of calculating NCES dropout counts based on existing Public Education Information Management System (PEIMS) data. The results for 1999-00 were submitted to NCES and are published in this supplement.

Two sets of annual dropout rates using the state definition of a dropout are published by TEA: one for Grades 7-12 and one for Grades 9-12. The TEA Grade 7-12 annual dropout rate is a base indicator in the accountability system. Grade 7-12 annual dropout rates are published for all districts and campuses with any grade levels between Grade 7 and Grade 12, inclusive, and for the state. The rates appear in TEA publications such as Academic Excellence Indicator System (AEIS) reports, School Report Cards, *Snapshot*, annual reports to the legislature, and annual high school completion and dropout reports.

TEA Grade 9-12 annual dropout rates are published in the annual completion and dropout report for all districts with any grade levels between Grade 9 and Grade 12, inclusive, and for the state. NCES publishes Grade 9-12 state and district annual dropout rates, although states report Grade 7 and Grade 8 dropouts in their data submissions to NCES. To facilitate comparisons between the TEA Grade 9-12 annual dropout rates and the NCES annual dropout rates, the agency will continue its policy of publishing detailed descriptions of the dropout

Texas Public School State Rates

The 1999-00 Grades 9-12 annual dropout rate for Texas public schools under the national definition was 5.0 percent (Table 3). The rate under the state definition was 1.8 percent. The NCES rate was 2.8 times the comparable TEA rate. For Grades 9-12, there were 54,390 dropouts under the NCES definition, compared to 21,439 dropouts under the TEA accountability definition – a difference of 32,951 students. The ratio of NCES dropouts to TEA dropouts for Grades 9-12 is 2.5 to 1.

NCES uses fall enrollment to calculate the dropout rate rather than the cumulative attendance used by TEA. This contributes to the higher dropout rate because fall enrollment is smaller than cumulative attendance, which includes all students enrolled at any time during the school year. Fall enrollment includes 1,088,428 students in Grades 9-12 while cumulative attendance includes 1,163,883 students, a difference of 75,455 students.

Under the state definition, the 1999-00 Grade 9-12 annual rate for African American, Hispanic, and White students was 2.6 percent, 2.7 percent, and 1.0 percent, respectively. Under the federal definition, the annual rate for African American, Hispanic, and White students was 6.8 percent, 7.3 percent, and 2.9 percent, respectively. The differences between TEA and NCES Grade 9-12 dropout counts vary slightly by ethnic group. The difference is largest for Asian/Pacific Islanders, with 2.8 times as many NCES dropouts as TEA dropouts. The difference is smallest for African Americans, with 2.4 times as many NCES dropouts as TEA dropouts.

The Grade 7-12 rate was 3.5 percent under the NCES dropout definition, compared to 1.3 percent under the TEA definition. Under the NCES dropout definition, 58,816 students in Grades 7-12 dropped out of Texas public schools in 1999-00, compared to 23,457 students under the TEA accountability definition – a difference of 35,359 students. The ratio of NCES dropouts to TEA dropouts for Grades 7-12 is 2.5 to 1.

Under both the TEA and NCES definitions, Grade 9 had the largest number of dropouts, followed by Grade 12 (Table 3). The difference between the TEA and NCES dropout counts is greatest for Grade 12. Several leaver categories that are dropouts under the NCES definition include a disproportionate number of Grade 12 students:

Beginning of the school year

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) designates the last Friday in October as the date on which static fall enrollment counts are made. The National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) procedures treat this day as the beginning of the school year.

TEA official dropouts

This is the count of official dropouts in Grades 9-12 in 1999-00 based on the Texas definition. The count includes students who drop out between the beginning of the school year in 1999 and the beginning of the school year in 2000. This dropout count is the numerator of the dropout rate used in the accountability ratings.

TEA students

This is the cumulative attendance of all students in Grades 9-12 for the 1999-00 school year. This count is the denominator of the TEA dropout rate.

TEA rate (%)

This is the TEA Grade 9-12 annual dropout rate for 1999-00.

Summer dropouts 1999-00

Dropouts who leave school after completing the 1999-00 school year are included in the TEA dropout count in 1999-00 but are included in the NCES dropout count in 2000-01. These dropouts are subtracted to calculate the NCES 1999-00 dropout count.

Summer dropouts 1998-99

Dropouts who leave school after completing the 1998-99 school year are included in the TEA dropout count in 1998-99 but are included in the NCES dropout count in 1999-00. These dropouts are added to calculate the NCES 1999-00 dropout count.

Other leavers

There are two categories of students reported to TEA as

NCES dropouts

This is the count of dropouts in Grades 9-12 in 1999-00 based on the NCES definition. The count includes students who drop out between the end of the 1998-99 school year and the end of the 1999-00 school year.

NCES rate (%)

This is the NCES Grade 9-12 event dropout rate for 1999-00.

NCES students

This is the denominator of the NCES dropout rate. The NCES definition uses enrollment on the date fall enrollment is counted.

Compliance Statement

Title VI, Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Modified Court Order, Civil Action 5281, Federal District Court, Eastern District of Texas, Tyler Division.

6. nondiscriminatory practices relating to the use of a student's first language; and
7. evidence of published procedures for hearing complaints and grievances.

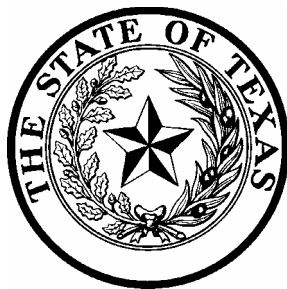
In addition to conducting reviews, the Texas Education Agency staff representatives check complaints of discrimination made by a citizen or citizens residing in a school district where it is alleged discriminatory practices have occurred or are occurring.

Where a violation of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act is found, the findings are reported to the Office for Civil Rights, U.S. Department of Education.

If there is a direct violation of the Court Order in Civil Action No. 5281 that cannot be cleared through negotiation, the sanctions required by the Court Order are applied.

Title VII, Civil Rights Act of 1964 as Amended by the Equal Employment Opportunity Act of 1972; Executive Orders 11246 and 11375; Equal Pay Act of 1964; Title IX, Education Amendments; Rehabilitation Act of 1973 as Amended; 1974 Amendments to the Wage-Hour Law Expanding the Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1967; Vietnam Era Veterans Readjustment Assistance Act of 1972 as Amended; Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986; Americans With Disabilities Act of 1990; and the Civil Rights Act of 1991.
