Participation Results for Texas Public Schools: SAT and ACT Combined

- A total of 182,281 Texas public high school graduates in the class of 2011 took the SAT, the ACT, or both examinations, an increase of 22,593 graduates from the previous class (Table 1). The overall participation rate for the class of 2011 (68.9%) wase@centage points higher than the rate for the class of 2010 (62.6%) (Table 1himspage and Figure 1 on page 4).
- Among graduates in the class of 2011, Asians had the highest participation rate, at 96.2 percent, followed by multiracial students (76.9%), African Americans (76.0%), Whites (74.9%), Pacific Islanders (69.8%), American Indians (65.7%), and Hispanics (59.0%) (Table 2).

Participation Results for Texas Public Schools: SAT

- A total of 147,960 graduates in the class of 2011 took the SAT examination (Table 5). The partiipation rate for the class of 2011 (56.0%) was 7.7 percentage points higher than the rate for the class of 2010 (48.3%).
- Among graduates in the class of 2011, Asians had the highest SAT participation rate, at 89.7 pe cent, followed by multiracial students (66.8%), African Americans (63.0%), Whites (62.1%), Pacific Islanders (60.2%), American Indians (54.2%), blispanics (45.3%) (Table 6).



Participation Results for Texas Public Schools: ACT

- A total of 91,943 graduates in the class of 2011 took the ACT examination (Table 8). The partic
 pation rate for the lass of 2011 (34.8%) was 2.1 percentage points higher than the rate for the
 class of 2010 (32.7%).
- Among graduates in the class of 2011, Asians had the highest ACT participation rate, at-41.1 pe cent, followed by Whites (39.4%), African Americans (38.0%) Itiracial students (36.5%), American Indians (32.2%), Pacific Islanders (30.5%), and Hispanics (29.2%) (Table 9 on page 10).

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
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
