The 8th TexasLegislatureSecond Called Sessi(8tr(2)) enacted Senate Bill (SB) 3. SB 3 (8r(2)), effective December 2, 2021, updates various instructional requirements and prohibitions enacted by House Bill (HB) 3979 during the Regular Session of the egislature(8r(R)) This letter provides highlights of SB 3 (8r(2)) and notes where relevant changes occurred from HB 3979 (8r(R)) that impact instructional requirements for school districts and openrollment charter schools. These highlights should not replace consultation with local counsel and other appropriate staff in implementing these legislative enactments.

A school district or opæmrollment charter school may not implement, interpret, or enforce any rule in a manner that would result in the punishment of a student for reasonablydiscussinghe concepts described by Subsection (a)(4) in school or during aschoolsponsored activity or have a chilling effect on reasonable student discussions involving those concepts in school or during a schoolsponsored activity[§28.0022(d)]
