1. What is the Texas STAREL Performance Measure?

The Texas STAR® EL Performance Measus whether or not an eligible ELis making sufficient progress on each STAAR contents assessment based on predetermined performance measure progress expectations. The subjectific STAAR erformance measure progress expectations consider the level of English language proficiency ELs possess, as well as the time needed to acquire English language ficiency to fully demonstrate gradevel academic skills in English. Texas English Language Proficiency Assessment System (TELPAS) data were used to evaluate the relationship between years in U.S. schools and English language proficiency.

STAAR and TELPAS data were used together to evaluate the relationship between English language proficiency and academic achievement. These relationships were used to **arsate**f STAAR performance measure progress expectations based on students' typical rate of English language acquisition

The EL Performance Measure methodology was reviewed with a variety of advisory groups, including the Texas Technical Advisory Committee (TTAC), the Accountability Aproisory Committee (APAC), and the Accountability Technical Advisory Committee (ATAC).

4. How dol know if a student will receive a reported ELPerformance Measure?

Tobe eligible for receiving the ELPerformane Measure a student must

- a. be in his or her second year in U.S. schools at the time of taking Tthe Rassessment
- b. have met all criteria and received a valid EL Performance Measuremy(Plan (see Question 6 on how eligiblestudents are placed intoELIM Plans)
- c. have a valid STAR score on the subject assessme(tut not STAR Spanis or STAR Alternate 2)

5. How does the El Performance Measure work?

Each eligible student is placed into an EL Performance Mea(SELLEM) Plan that specifies the expected number of ears it should take for the student to reach the STAAR performance.levels

Based on students' ELPM Plans that they are placed in and their years in U.S. thutiostale scores on each STAAR assessment are compared to the performance nperagrees expectations that have been established by the Texas Education Agents in each STAR content-area assessment (see Question 6 on howeligible students are placed into ELPMPlans)
