
1 AN ACT relating to requiring the Texas Education Agency to conduct a study 2 to develop a writing assessment method for public school students and establish a pilot program to administer the assessment method developed. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 39, Education Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 39.02301 to read as follows: 8 9 Sec. 39.02301. WRITING ASSESSMENT STUDY; PILOT PROGRAM. (a) During the 2015-2016 school year, the agency, in coordination 10 11 with the entity that has been contracted to develop or implement assessment instruments under Section 39.023, shall conduct a study 12 to develop a writing assessment method as an alternative to the 13 14 writing assessment instruments required under Sections 39.023(a) and (c). The writing assessment method must be designed to assess: 15 16 (1) a student's mastery of the essential knowledge and skills in writing through timed writing samples; 17 (2) improvement of a student's writing skills from the 18 19 beginning of the school year to the end of the school year; 20 (3) a student's ability to follow the writing process 21 from rough draft to final product; and 22 (4) a student's ability to produce more than one type
