

Schema Changes:

When TREx v 3.3 is released, XML files which point to an older version of the schema will still upload. However, to be able to validate against the new schema and report the new PEIMS codes, the XML extract must be modified to reference the new schema, v1.2.

For example:

XML file pointing to v1.1 of the TREx XSD <trex:TRExStudentRecords
xmlns:trex="urn:us:tx:state:tea:TREx:v1.1">

XML file pointing to v1.2 of the TREx XSD <trex:TRExStudentRecords
xmlns:trex="urn:us:tx:state:tea:TREx:v1.2">

We will post the new xsd file on the TREx website in the next few days under New Features. To validate an XML file against the new XML Schema (XSD), download the xsd file and :

- Use an XML editor that supports schema validation (i.e. XMLSpy, Oxygen XML, Stylus Studio). A more comprehensive list of tools providers can be found at (<http://www.w3.org/XML/Schema>)
- Or use an API that supports XML/XSD validation (i.e. Xerces, Saxon,MSXML)
