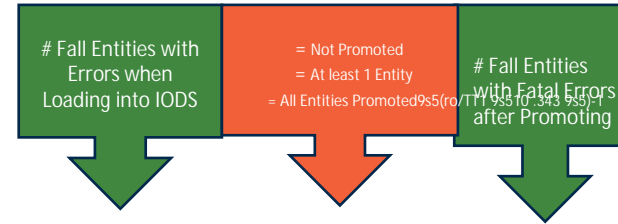

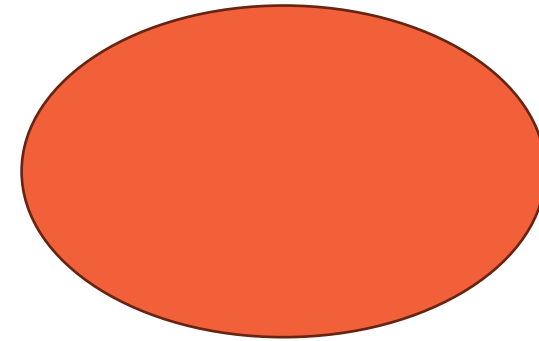

HOW TO SUBMIT AN ISSUE






STEPS FOR EACH LEA to^t submission

1 Ensure TEAL access has been approved for TSDS Portal, DMC, PEIMS, and ^Core. 

2 Ensure a Key & Secret has been created for each SIS, ERP, and ^ECDS vendor. 

3 Coordinate with your vendors to send data to the TSDS IODS. 

4 Coordinate with your vendors to resolve any Level 1 (API) errors. 

5 Verify data is publishing as expected in the DMC.

6 Schedule and review Level 2 Business Validations.

7 Promote TSDS PEIMS and Core data through the TSDS applications. 

8 Verify TSDS submissions with the available data validations and reports. 

9 Run the TSDS PEIMS Disaggregation Report & compare to your source system data.

EXPECTATIONS & ACTIONS

POSSIBLE ISSUES

1. LEAs may be required to cleanup their source data due to data standard.
2. Vendor products may need to be updated throughout the year.
3. Vendor technology issues may arise due to specific LEA integrations.
4. LEAs will need additional support on specific issues during the transition.

SUPPORTS

1. Regional Educational Service Centers are available to assist LEAs.
2. Dedicated TEA Vendor Coordinator is available to triage communication.
3. TEA technical staff are available to provide guidance when applicable.
4. Established support ticket system is available to report and monitor issues.

ED-FI DATA STANDARD

- f*Set of data standards and technology that allows local school systems to gain access to real time tools to support students via individual LEA Operational Data Store (ODS)
- f*Version 4.0 allows for the submission of data using
instead of
 - f*which will improve system performance and reduce the burden of bulk loading for schools;
 - f*allows schools to have access to their data sooner; identify errors sooner and correct data sooner;
 - f*provides a mechanism for near real-time sync of the school system's individual ODS and their local systems along with TEA tools.

TSDS Upgrade Helps Schools and Improves Student Supports

f Implementing API transactional data loads:

1. Allows school systems to integrate with other local systems that are Ed-Fi compliant, including:

f Early warning systems that alert administrators to absenteeism

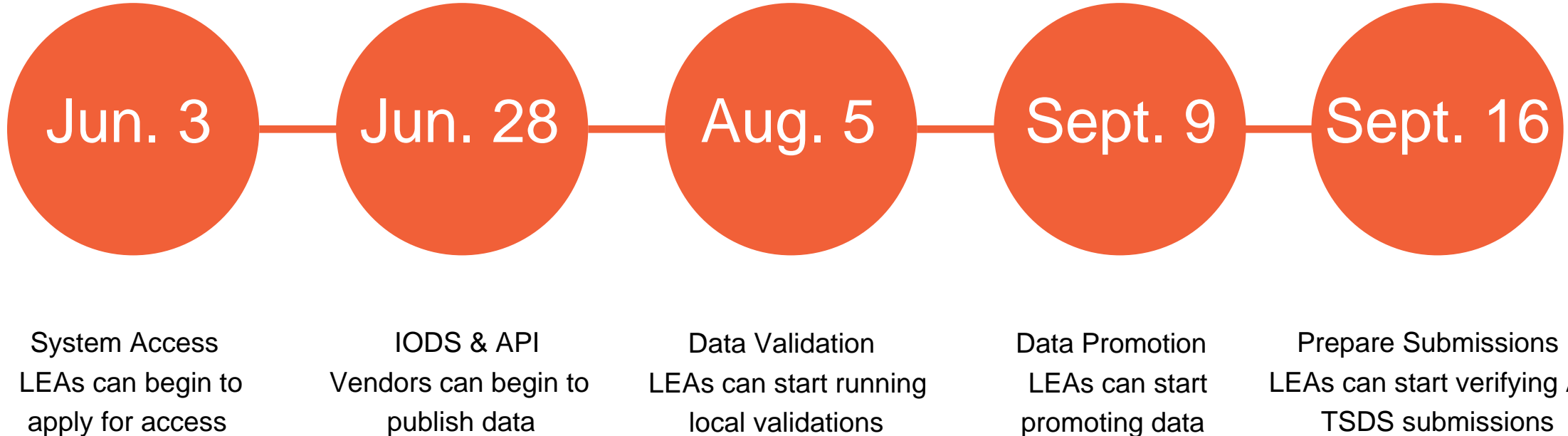
f Graduation Plan advisement tools

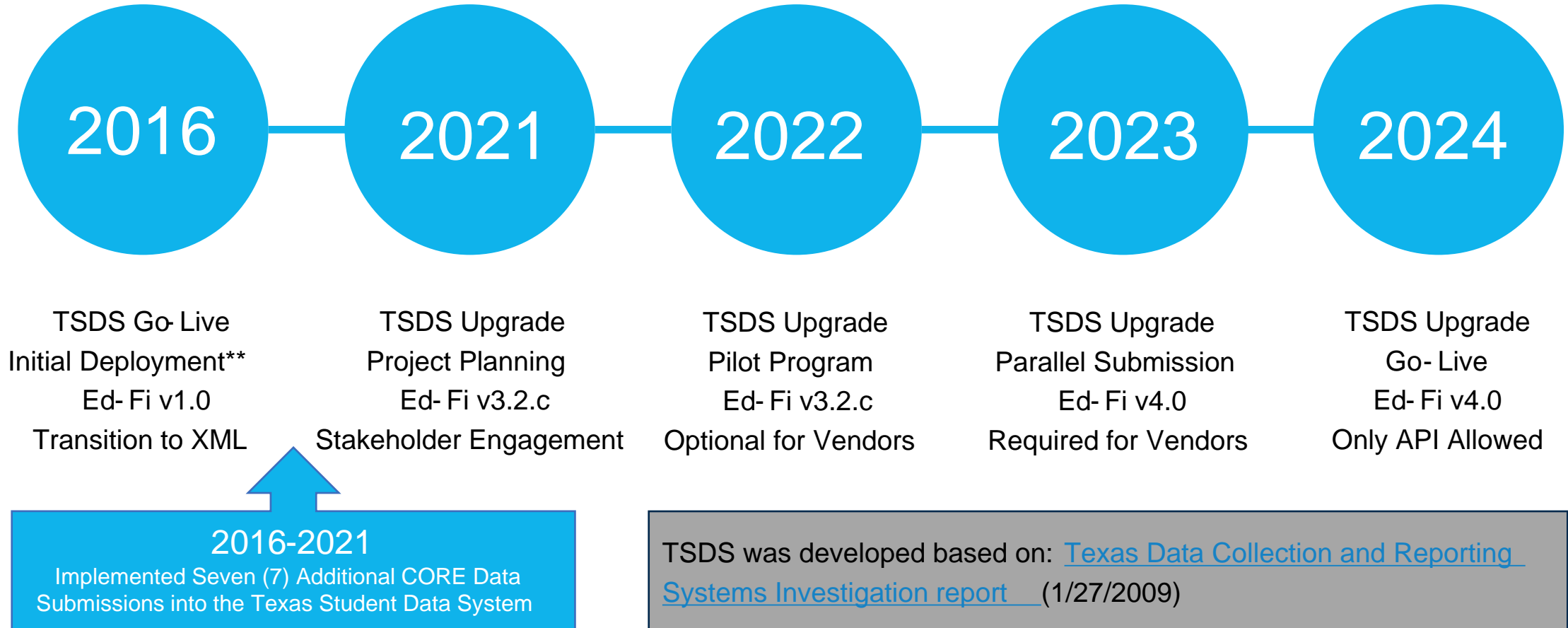

TSDS HISTORY & TIMELINE



TSDS was developed based on: [Texas Data Collection and Reporting Systems Investigation report](#) (1/27/2009)

**Moved LEAs from a PEIMS data reporting system, EDIT+ that had been in existence since 1987. This system was based on an 80-column flat file format for submitting data.

PROJECT TIMELINE

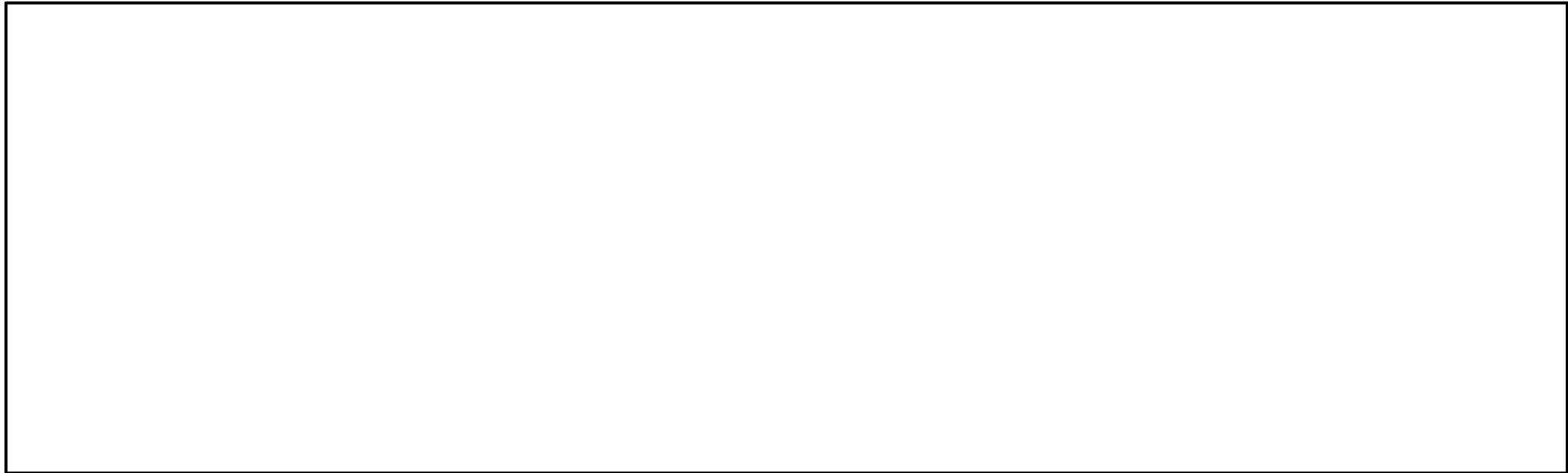
- 9 Most TSDS vendors participated to develop and test their product solutions.
- 9 Limited number of LEAs conducted testing against PEIMS Fall, Class Roster, and Child Find.

- 9 All TSDS vendors participated and tested their product solutions in a Production-like environment.
- 9 In partnership with school systems, TEA and vendors were able to make iterative software updates, ultimately confirming full data comparisons for every data collection between the old system and the new system.

- % All LEAs will submit their TSDS data through the API.
- % XML submissions are no longer accepted for TSDS.
- % Charter School Waitlist Submission due October 25, 2024.
- % PEIMS Fall Submission due December 12, 2024.



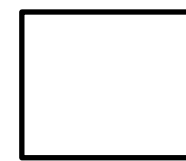
2024-2025 PRODUCTION – Charter School Waitlist & PEIMS Fall

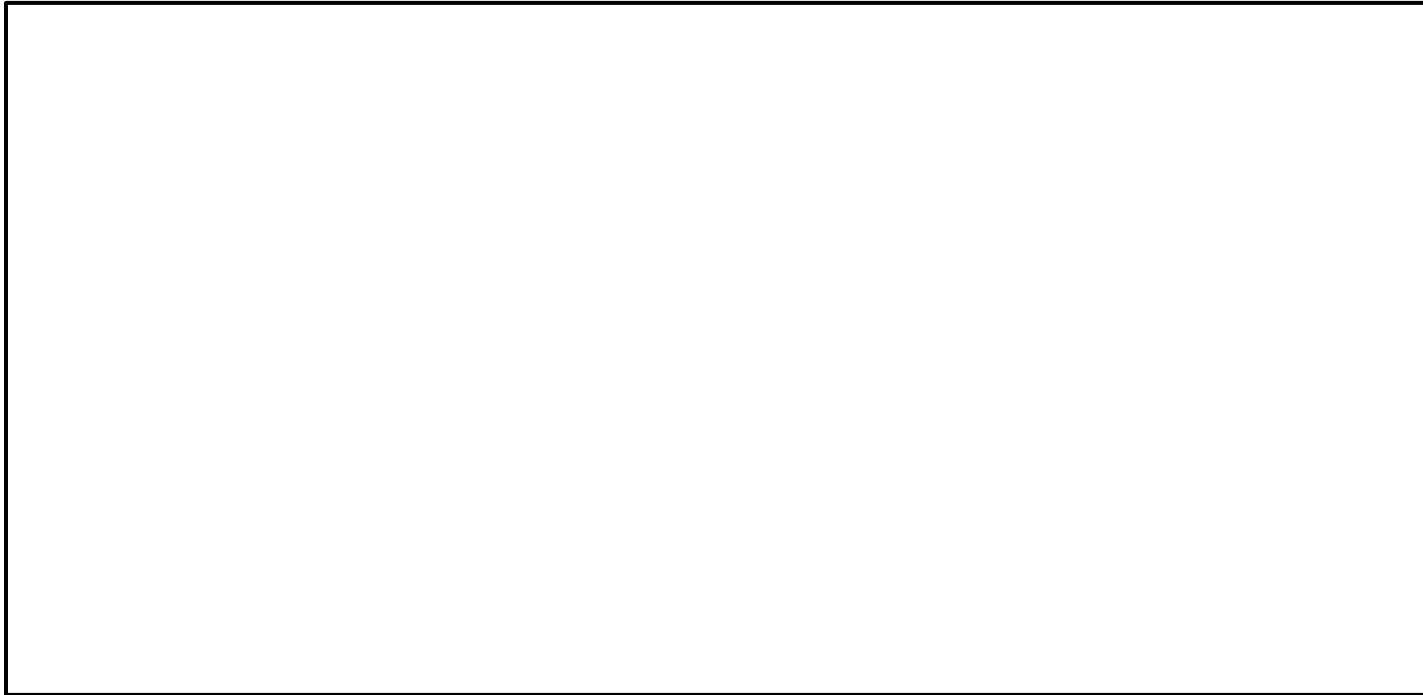

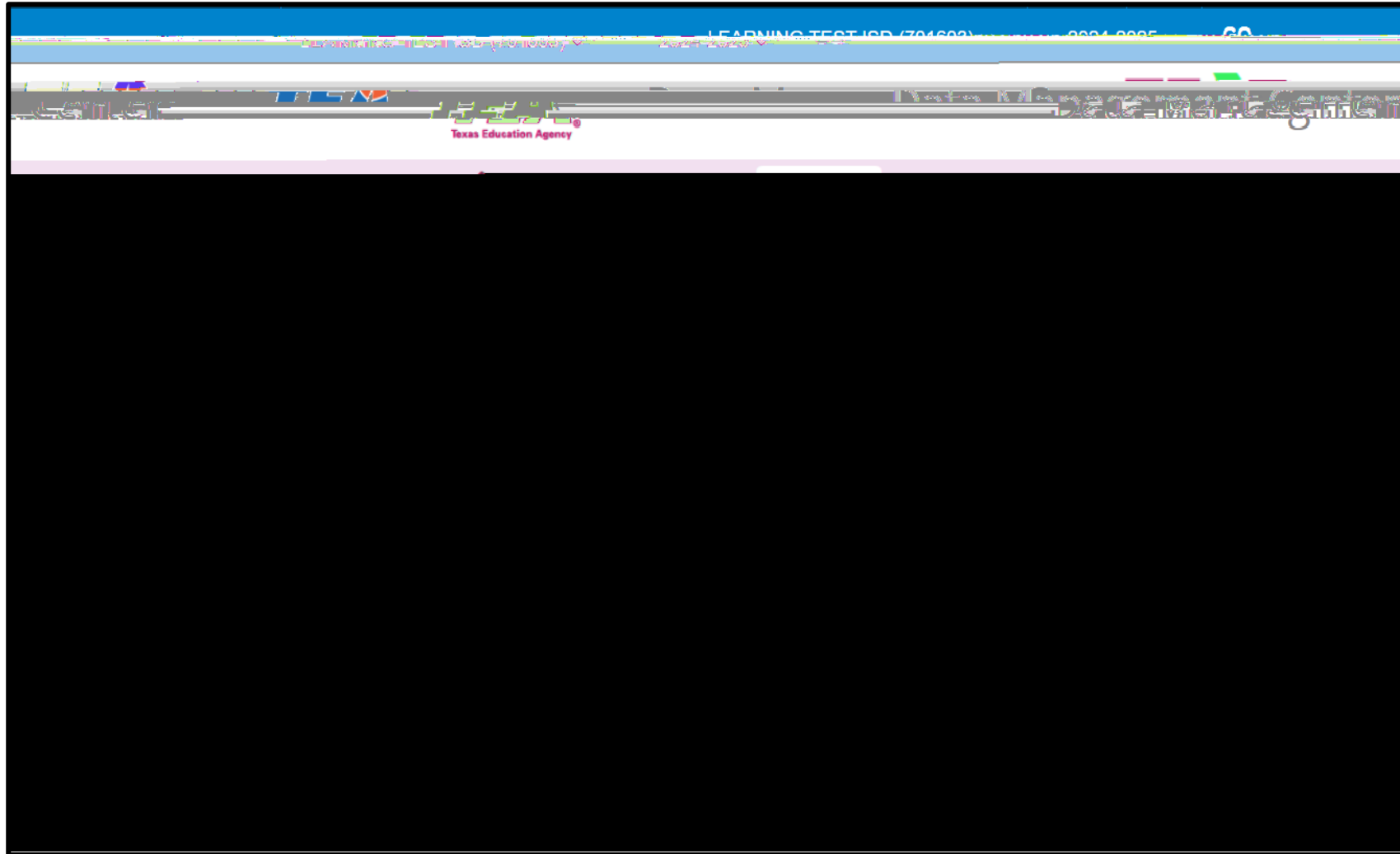

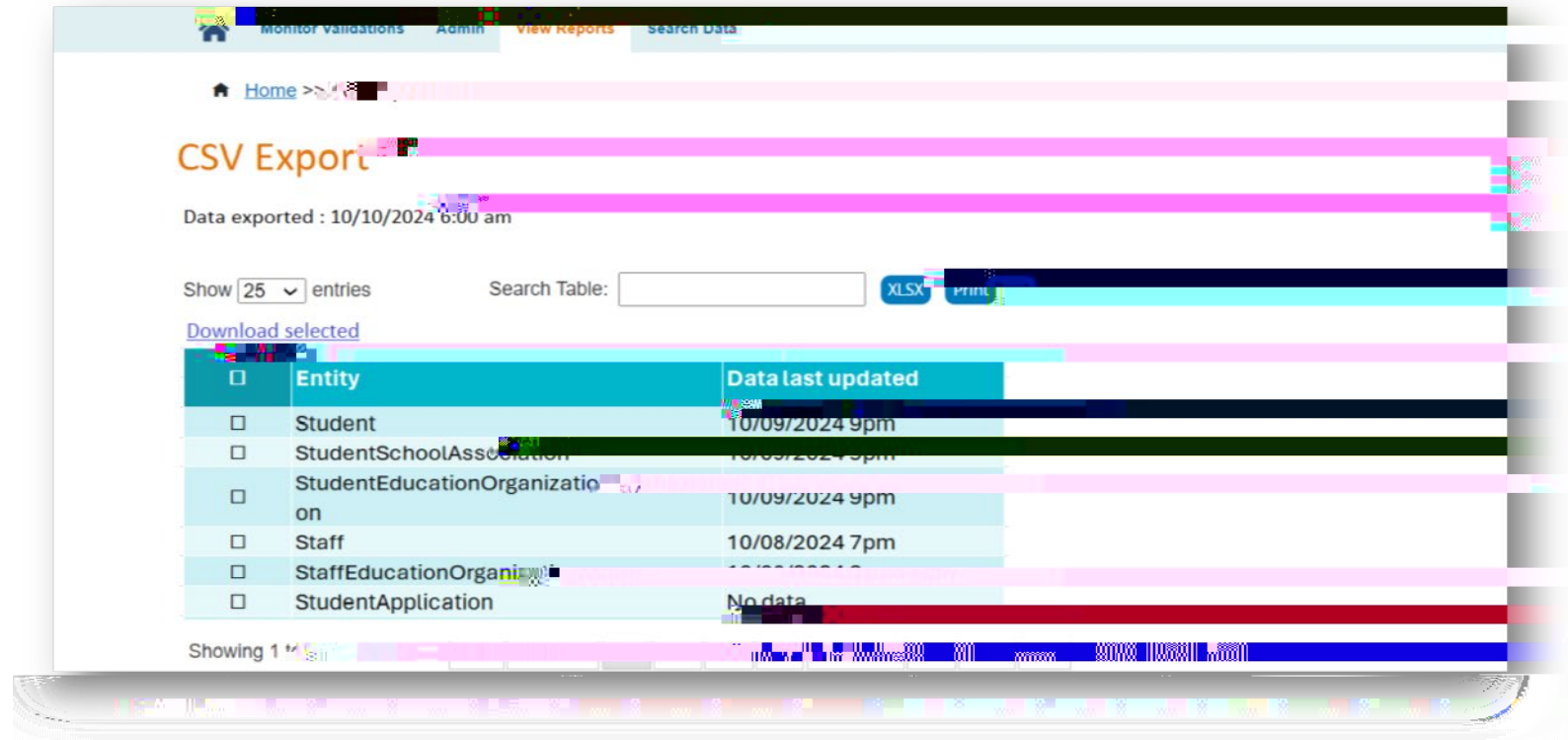
