Required Actions if Individuals with Textinfirmed Cases Have Been in a School

exclude students from the nding school in person who are actively sick with COVID19, or who have received a positive testsult for COVID19, and must immediately notify parents if this is determined while on campus

Parents must ensure they do not send a child to school on campus if the child has 13OVID symptoms or is testconfirmed with COVID9, until the conditions for re-entry are make the DSH3ule for more details, including the conditions for ending the exclusion period and returning to school.

During the exclusion period, the school system may deliver remote insy rv enm m

Alternately, students cannot the stayat-home period if they receive regative result from a PCR acute infection teafter the close contact exposurends

During the stayat-home period, the school system may deliver remote instruction consistent with the practice of remote conferencing outlined in the proposed Student Attendance Accounting Handboo(SAAH) rules, as described here

Staff Who Have COVID or Who are Close Contacts

Similar to students, chool systems must exclude staff from attending school in person who are actively sick with COVID9, who are suspected of being actively swith COVID19, or who have received a positive test result for COVID-Based on recent updates from tback, staff may return when:

- x If symptomatic, at least 5 days have passed since symptom onset, and fever free*, and other symptoms have improved.
- x For those with no symptoms, at least 5 days after the day they texted ive

Staff who meet the close contact threshold with a COV1D positive individual are in one of the following groups, do not need to stay at home

- x Ages 18 or older and have received all recommended vaccine doses, including boosters and additional primary shots for some immunocompromised people.
- x Wasconfirmed COVID 9 positive within the last 90 dayand has fully recovered

For staff who meet the close contact threshold with a COMP ositive individual who are not in one of the above groups, it is recommended that the collapse system require that staff remain off campus during the start-home period, but this is a local employment policy decision. these staff continue to work on campus, rapid testing must be performed

^{*}Fever free for 24 hours without the use fever suppressing medications. Fever is a temperature of 100° Fahrenheit (37.8° Celsius) or higher.
