



Dear parents, families, teachers, staff, and community members of South San Antonio ISD:

The Texas Education Agency’s (TEA) mission is to improve outcomes for all public school students in the state by providing leadership, guidance, and support to school systems. As such, you may be aware that in September 2023, the TEA entered into an agreement with South San Antonio Independent School District (SSAISD) after a yearslong investigation found that the Board of Trustees violated multiple laws relating to governance, including neglecting to collaborate with the district superintendent and operating outside of their authority. The agreement provided SSAISD twelve months, with the support of a conservator, to significantly improve the operations of its governance leadership team. Now that the twelve-month period has ended, the Commissioner of Education is evaluating whether

TEA acknowledges that the Commissioner's decisions may require significant change to your district. The agency is committed to a fair and transparent process that benefits all students in SSAISD and looks forward to engaging with you during our community meetings.
